

ANDALUSIAN DIVISION

USEF and IALHA Rated

This horse show is licensed by the USEF (United States Equestrian Federation) and the IALHA (International Andalusian and Lusitano Horse Association), and is open to both purebred and half-bred horses. It is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rulebook and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Each participant in this horse show is responsible for knowledge of and is subject to the rules of both the IALHA and the USEF. All horses entered must be registered with or eligible for registration with IALHA. Weanlings and yearlings are eligible if both sire and dam are registered with IALHA. Copies of registration papers **MUST** be mailed with entries. Back numbers will not be issued to exhibitors until all papers have been checked. Copies of USEF and IALHA membership cards must be sent with entries or non-member fees must be included with entry fee payment. IALHA non-member fee is \$25 per horse. See page 8 for USEF fees.

1. **DRESSAGE HACK.** To sit or rise the trot shall be at the riders discretion at this show.
2. **DRESSAGE SUITABILITY.** No horse may be shown in Dressage Suitability once it has been shown in Dressage Hack. No horse over 7 years of age may be shown in Dressage Suitability. Whether to sit or rise the trot shall be at the rider's discretion at this show.
3. **WALK AND FAVORITE GAIT.** Horses to enter the ring at the walk in a counterclockwise direction. Exhibitors will walk and upon the judge's instructions take their favorite gait both ways of the arena. They will be required to halt, stand quietly and back readily. A quiet mouth is imperative. Judged on manners, performance, way of going. Entries in this class may show in other classes at this show.
4. **OBEDIENCE (ENGLISH/WESTERN).** Exhibitors enter the arena at the gait and in the direction called for by the judge. Exhibitors will walk, trot and canter both ways of the arena. Additional movements may include canter departures from a walk, halts, backing, side passing, turns on haunches or forehand, counter leads, counter leads on a circle, simple lead changes and flying lead changes, etc. Judge will eliminate exhibitors based on faults and last remaining exhibitor on rail is the winner.
5. **ENGLISH SHOW HACK.** To sit or rise the trot shall be at the riders discretion at this show.
6. **HOOF BLACK.** Hoof Black is permitted.
7. **HALTER LEADS.** Halter leads may not exceed 12' in length.
8. **IALHA Qualifications:** A first, second or third place finish qualifies the entry for the 2007 IALHA Regional and National Championship Show in that class. Entries must declare the division in which they wish to qualify, i.e. Open, Amateur or Junior.
