

PASO FINO DIVISION

USEF and PFHA Licensed (AB)

This show is licensed by USEF (United States Equestrian Federation) and PFHA (Paso Fino Horse Association). It is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rulebook and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. To be eligible for showing, horses must be registered with the Paso Fino Horse Association and must be entered and exhibited under their full registered names and numbers. All participants (owners, agents, lessees, trainers, riders, exhibitors and handlers) must be current members of and in good standing with PFHA. Copies of current USEF membership cards and front and back of PFHA registration papers must be included with entry. Amateurs must be in possession of both USEF and PFHA Amateur certification.

NOTE: Double Points. This is a PFHA double-pointed show with (two) single judges for all three days .

1. **PRIZES:** Trophies are awarded to first place and ribbons to fifth in regular classes and fourth in championship classes.
2. **LARGO RACE:** As determined by the judge, horses may start at a running start or at a standstill. The number of laps will be determined by the size of the arena. Each horse has a spotter. If the horse breaks gait, the judges will call that horse out of the race. The winner is the horse that stays in good largo and crosses the finish line first. (Optionally the judge may ask the horse to halt, step out of the line and later resume the race.) Cash prizes in the Largo Race will be \$100 (100% To The Winner).
3. Prize Money is paid to the owner of the horse and does not effect USEF or PFHA Amateur status.
